What is AAPI Heritage Month?

AAPI (Asian-American and Pacific Islander) Heritage Month is a celebration of Asians and Pacific Islanders. AAPI encompasses all of the Asian continent and the islands of Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia. "Asian/Pacific American Heritage Week" was observed nationally from May 4-11, 1979. In 1990, Congress expanded the observation to a month.




1787




1919






Comedian and pop singer Ray Stevens begins a 3-week run at #1 on the Billboard Hot 100 when his song "The Streak" takes the top spot.
