The End-of-Course Assessment is designed to see how well students understand the material covered during their first semester and is aligned with Ohio's Academic Content Statements.

Two different types of questions will appear on this test: multiple choice and short answer responses. Specifically:

- 35 multiple choice questions @ 2 points each = 70 total points
- 2 short answer questions @ 15 points each = 30 total points
- This test is worth 100 points and constitutes 20% of a student's Semester grade.

- A. At the end of the war, Cuba became a Spanish colony.
- B. At the end of the war, Puerto Rico and Guam became U.S. territories.
- C. The Treaty of Versailles ended the Spanish-American War.
- D. At the end of the war, the Philippines won their independence from the U.S.
