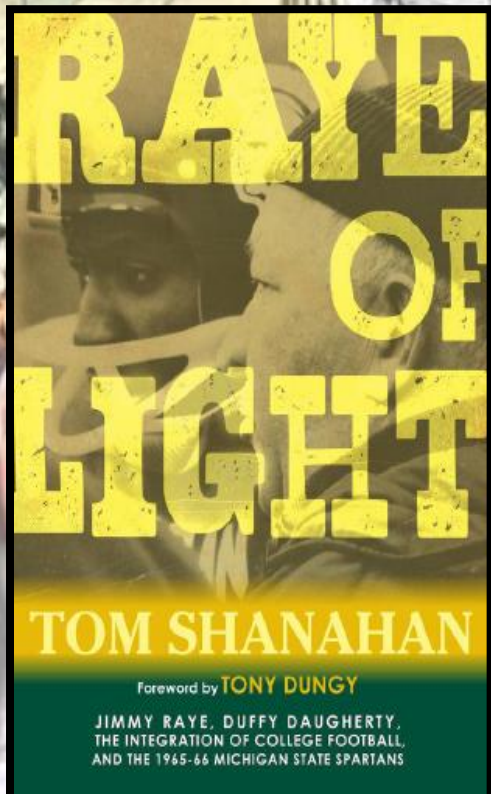
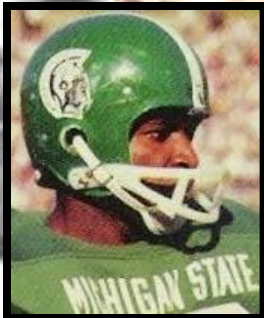


## RAYE OF LIGHT – PART 5:

You will submit your “Fast Five” answers via e-mail.

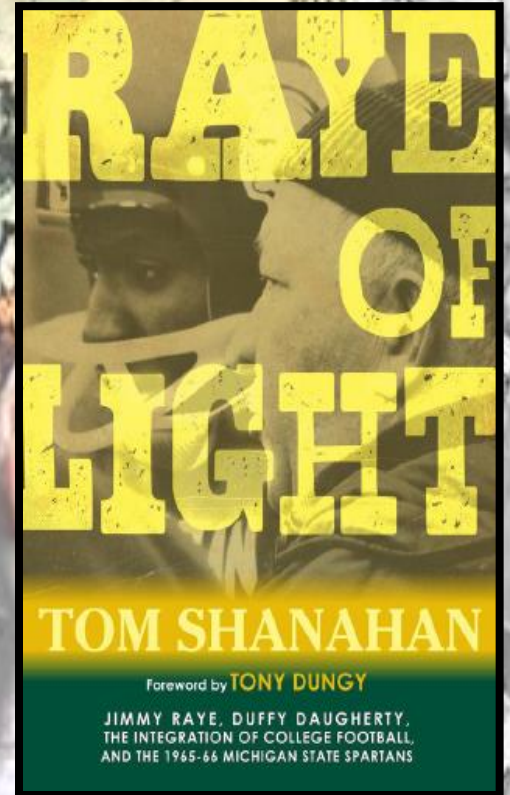
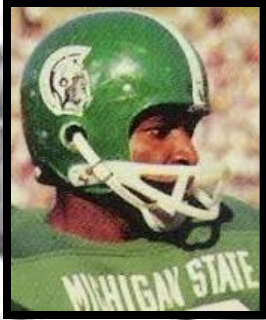


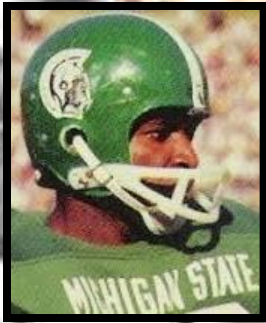
