1793

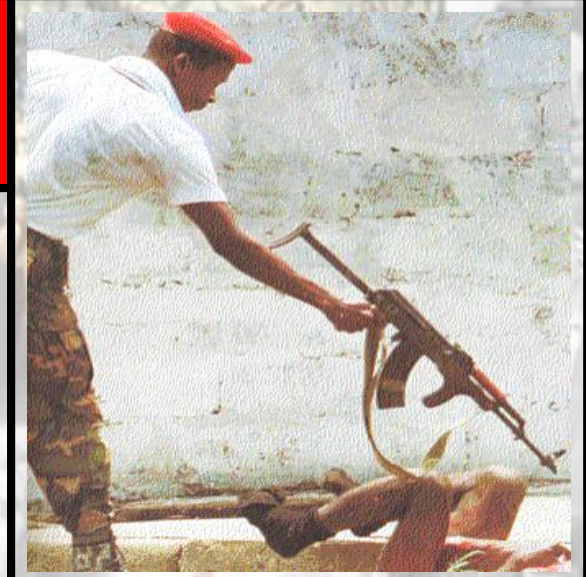
