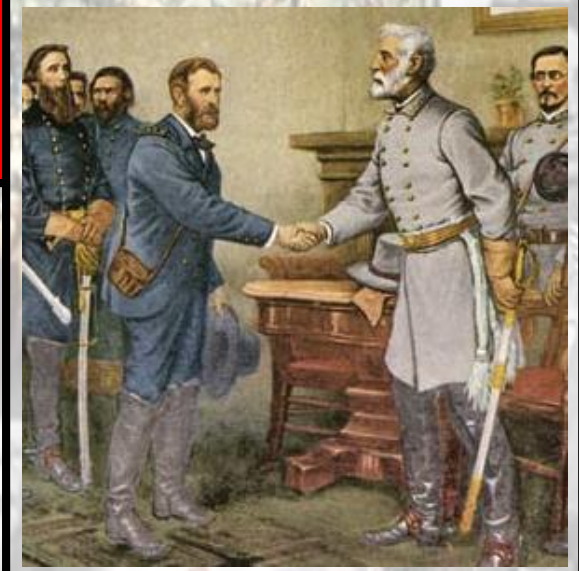

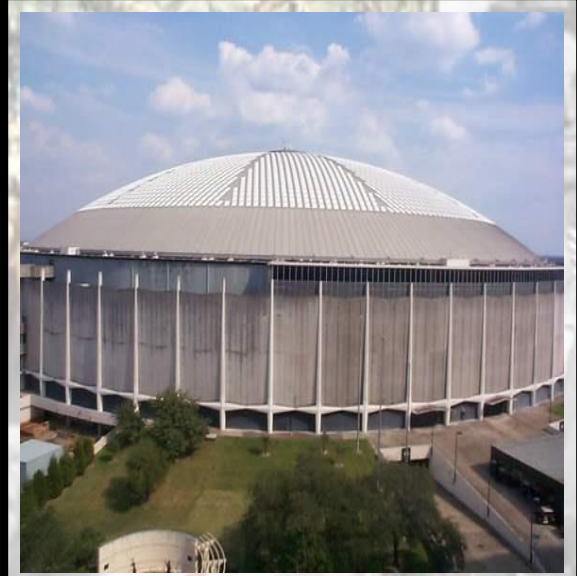


# 1965

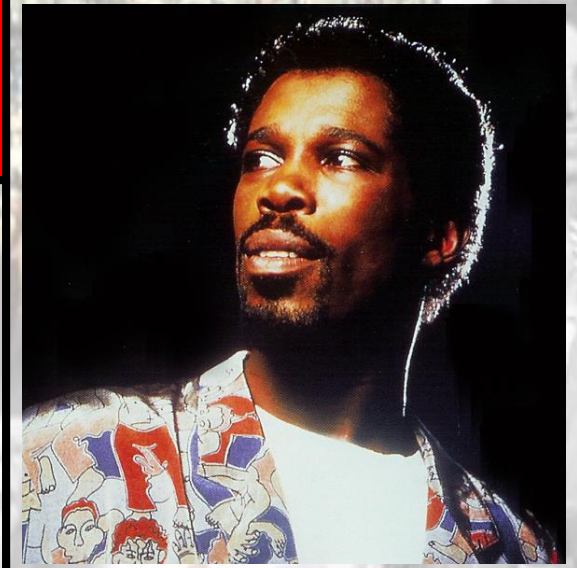


# 1988
