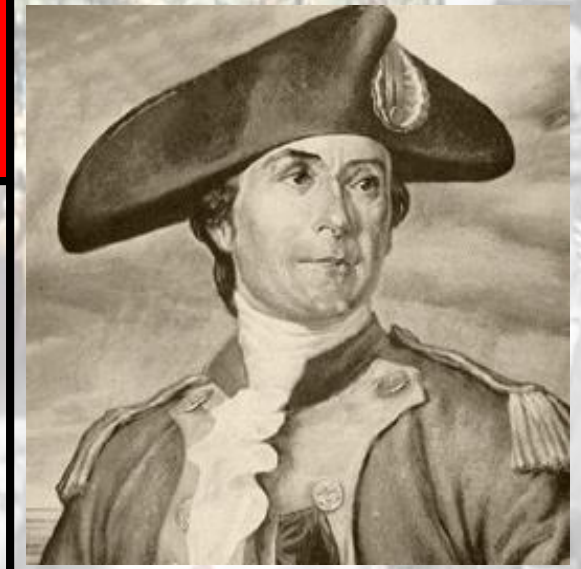


1778

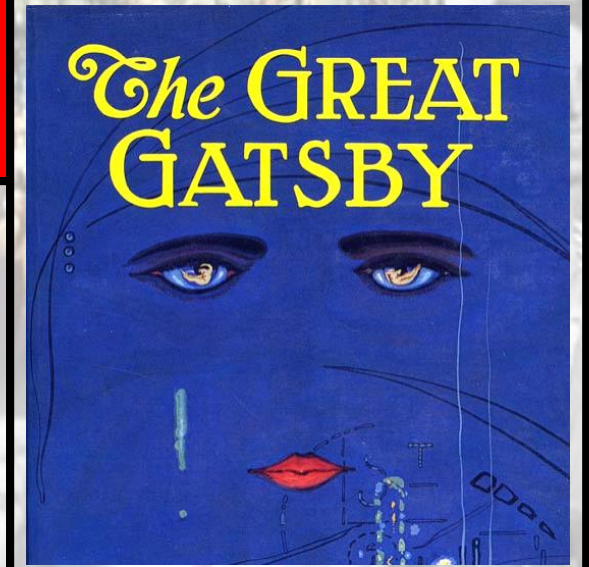

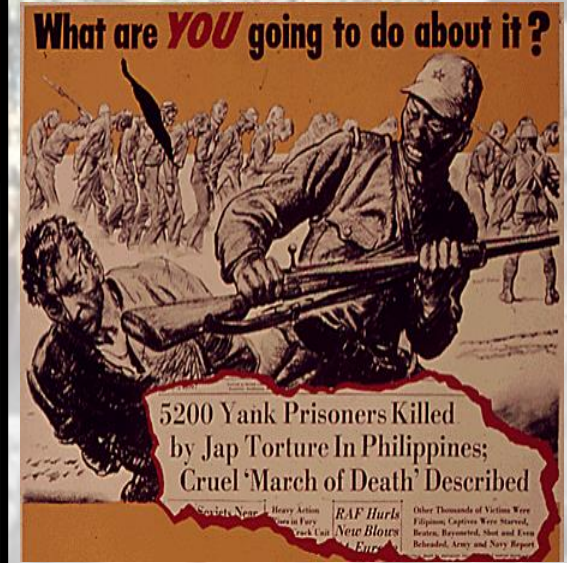

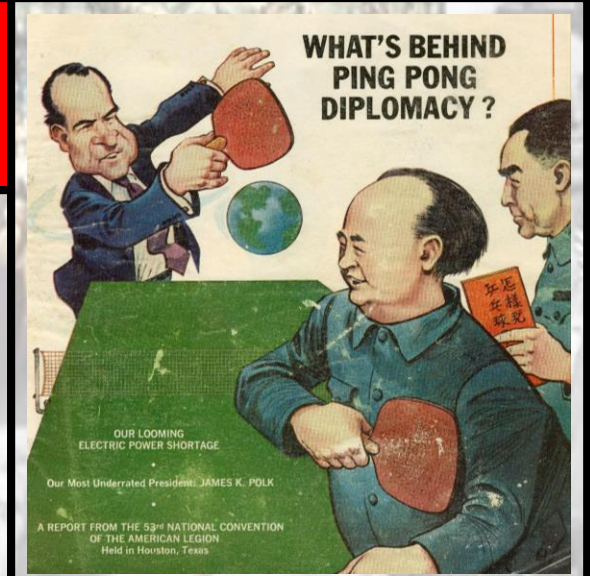


1971
