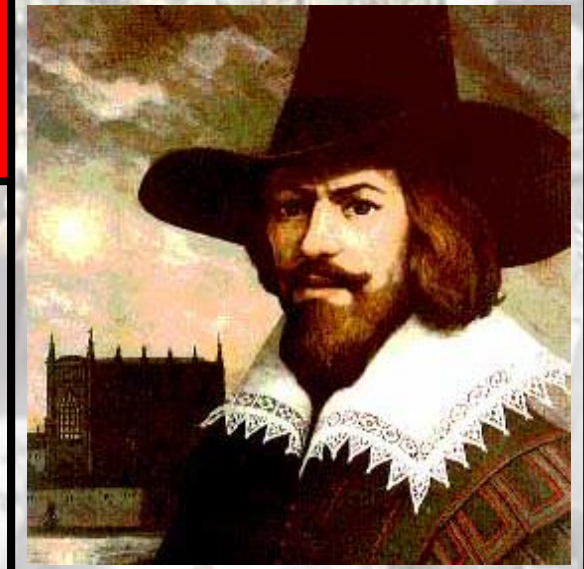


1570

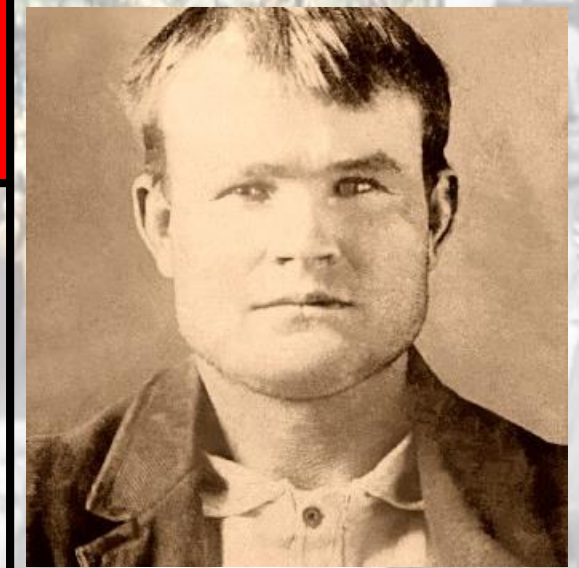

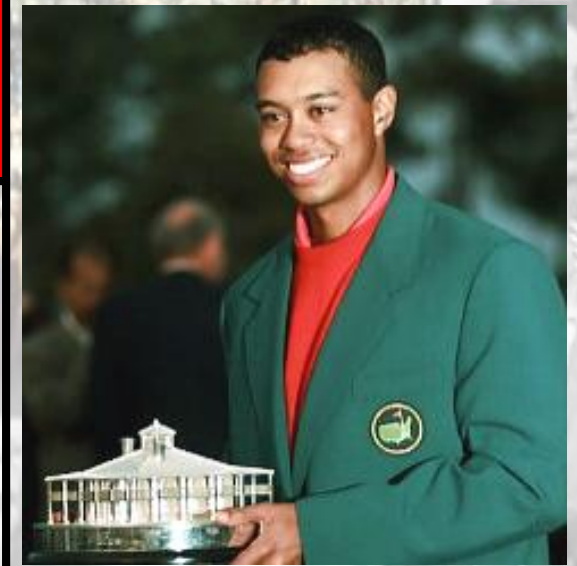


1997
