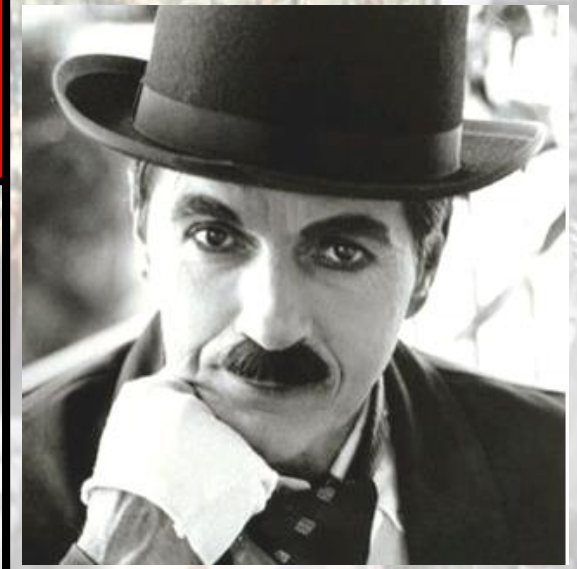

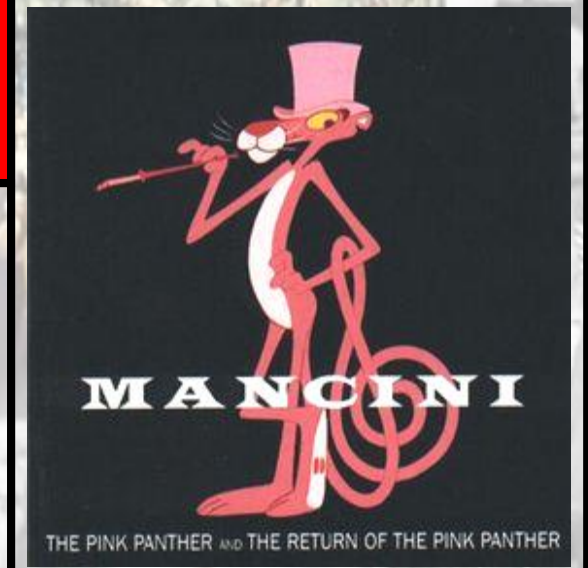

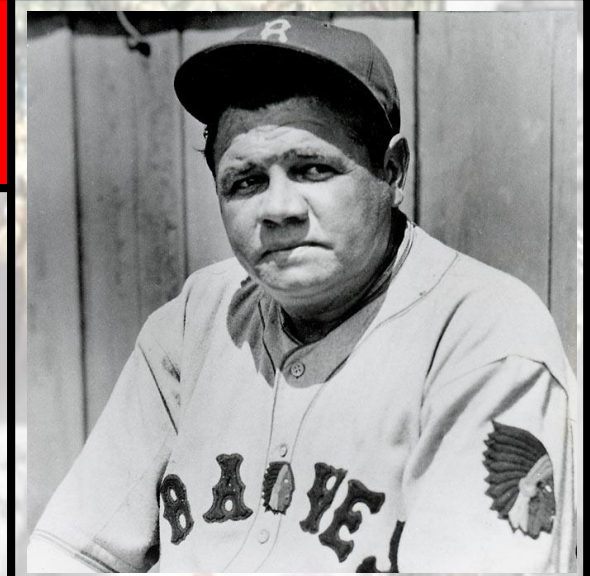

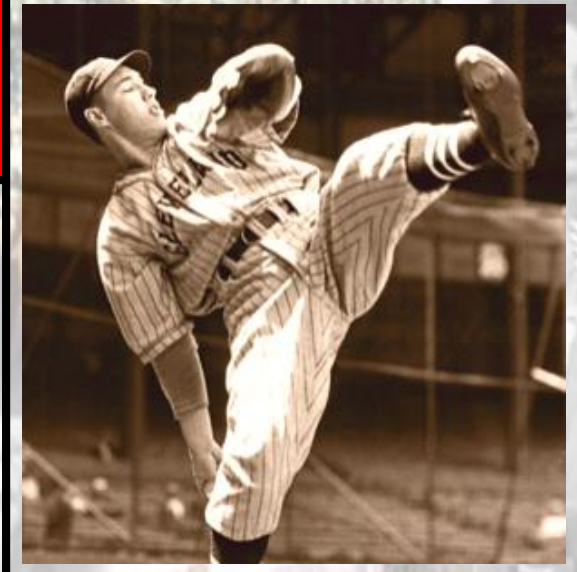

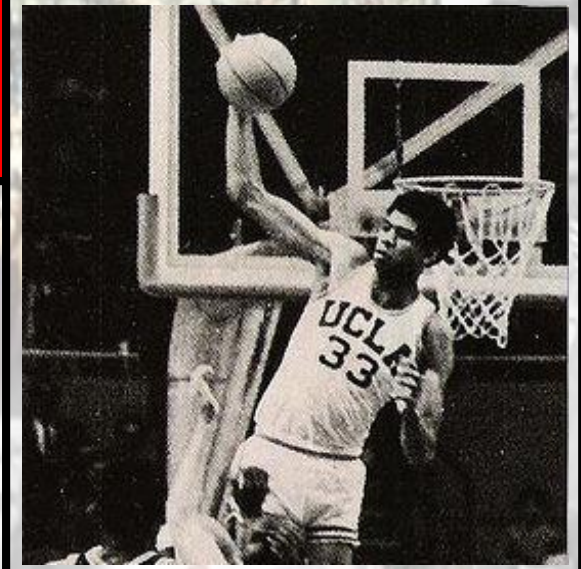


1947
