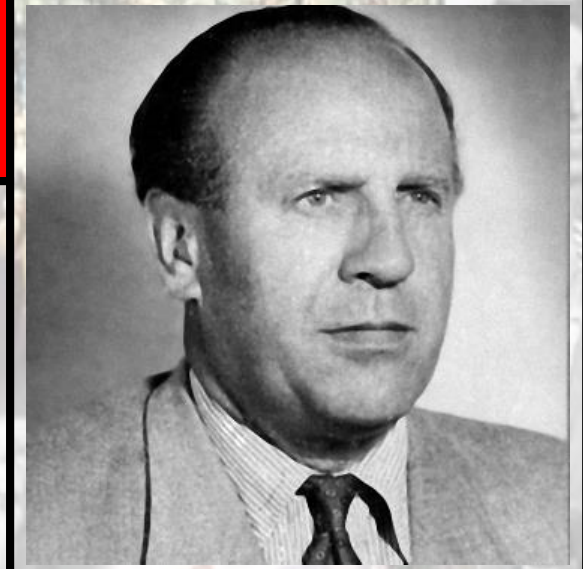

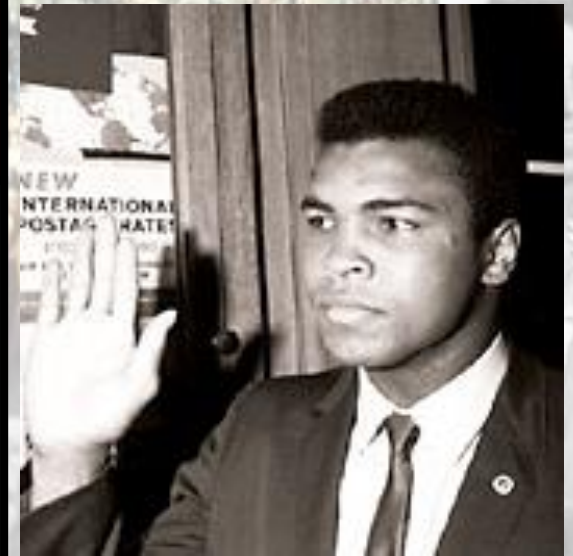


1967
