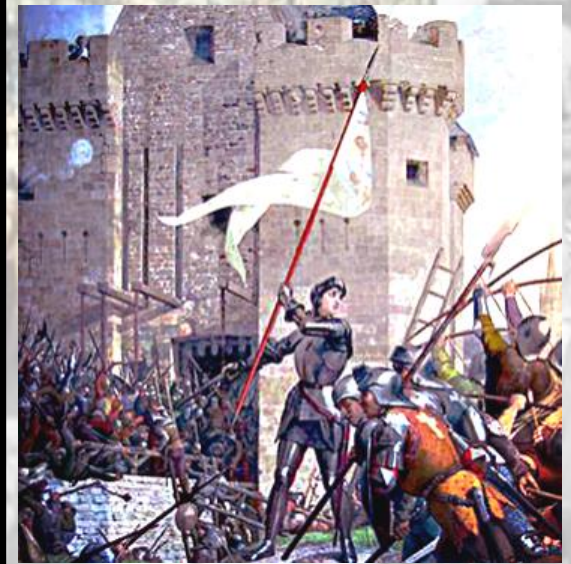


1429

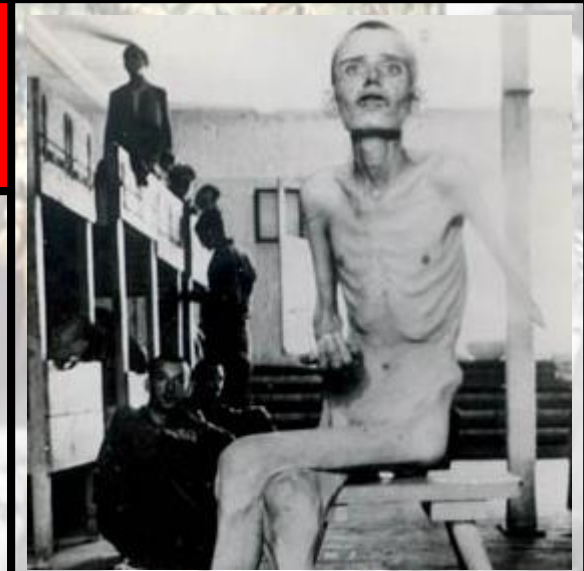


1945

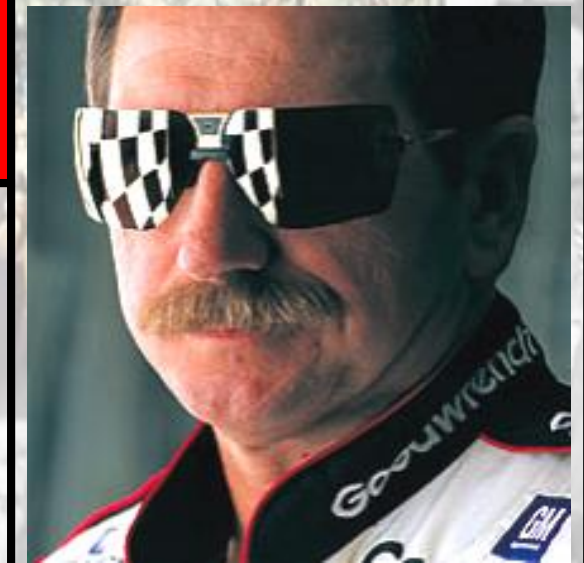

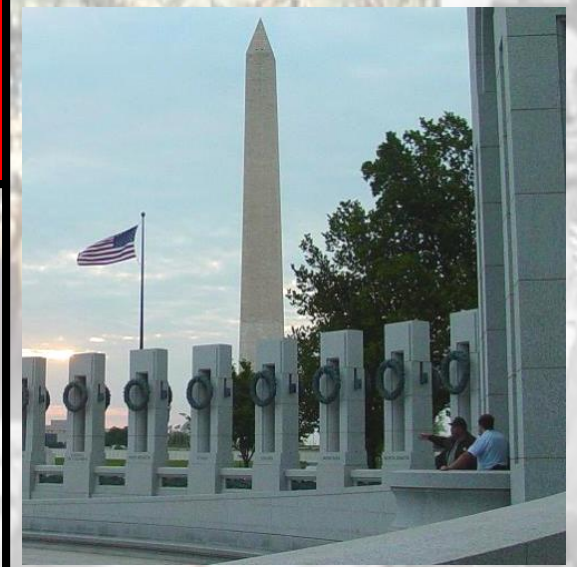
