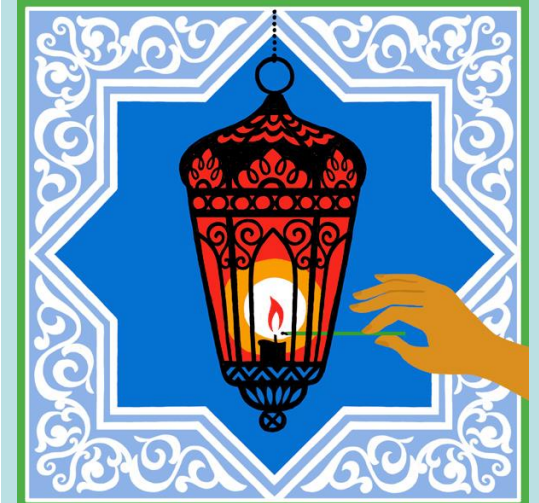

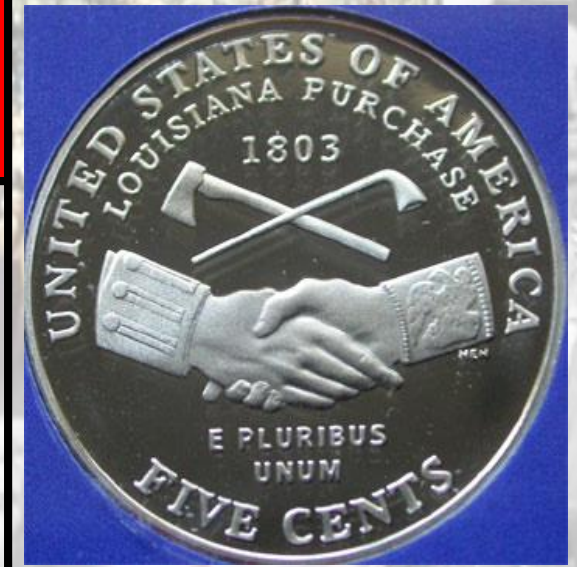

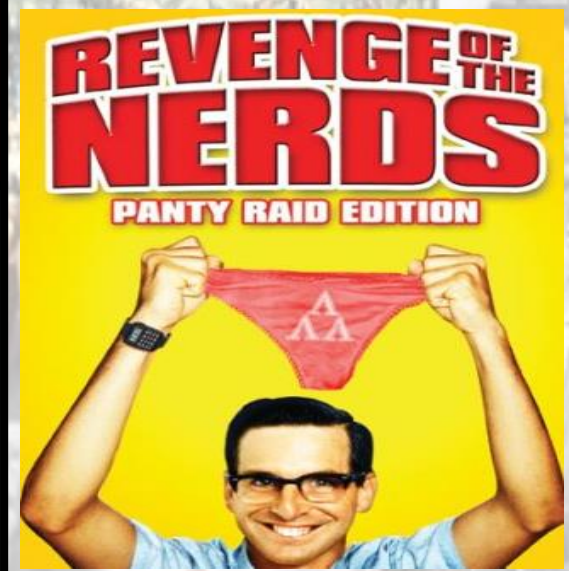


1955

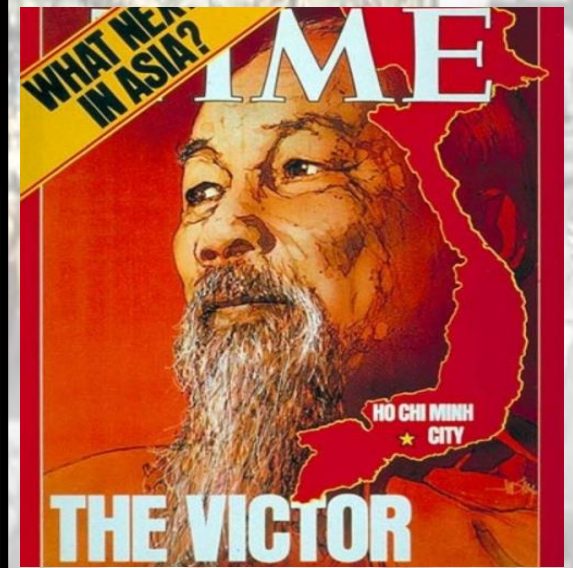


1975
