What is Black History Month?

In February 1926, black historian Dr.
Carter G. Woodson organized the celebration of "Negro History Week" during the second week of February in honor of the birthdays of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln. The week-long celebration grew in popularity, and by the early 1970s, it expanded to include the entire month.







INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL PERSONS OF **JAPANESE**

Living in the Following Area:

All that portion of the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, I jung generally west of the north-south line established by Junipero Serra Boulevard, Worrhester Avenue, and Nineteenth Avenue, and Jung generally north of the extivest line established by California Street, to the intersection of Market Street, and thence on Market Street and thence on Market Street.

All Japanese persons, both alien and non-alien, will be evacuated from the above designated area by 1200 which noon Tuesday, April 7, 1942.

No Japanese person will be permitted to enter or leave the above described area after 800 a.m., Thursday, April 2, without obtaining special permission from the Provost Manhal at the Giril Control Scatter.




