In 1909, March 8<sup>th</sup> was recognized as International Women's Day. In 1978, schools in Sonoma, CA held a "Women's History Week" during the week of March 8<sup>th</sup>. In 1987, Congress expanded the celebration to all of March.






WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH






WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH






WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH
