#### What is AAPI Heritage Month?

AAPI (Asian-American and Pacific Islander) Heritage Month is a celebration of Asians and Pacific Islanders. AAPI encompasses all of the Asian continent and the islands of Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia. "Asian/Pacific American Heritage Week" was observed nationally from May 4-11, 1979. In 1990, Congress expanded the observation to a month.






1862

Richard and Maurice McDonald open the first McDonald's in San Bernardino, CA. In 1955, they sold the franchise to Ray Kroc for \$2.5 M (or \$21.8 M today).




1972
