

What is Native American Month?

Native American Heritage Month started in **1986** when President Ronald Reagan proclaimed the week of **November 23-30, 1986** as “Native American Week”. In **1990**, President George H. W. Bush signed a law designating the entire month of November as a time to celebrate the culture and contributions of the people who were the nation’s first inhabitants.



All over Germany, Nazis destroy 7,500 Jewish shops, burn 267 synagogues, kill 91, and arrest 25,000. It is called *Kristallnacht*, or “Night of the Broken Glass”.




1965






2005
