You will cap off your unit requirements by completing a Unit Test. All tests are taken in-class and on-line via Schoology. The Unit Tests are worth **100 points**. While not open for re-assessment, they are occasionally curved.

The Unit Test is given the day before all assignments are due. That being said, you are still encouraged to turn in all of your Common Lits, your Movie Review, your two Mini-Projects, and your Big Project before the test.

Not attempting a test (absences aside) will result in automatic failure for that assessment.
