Unit Test

How do I take a test in here?

You will cap off your unit requirements by completing a Unit Test. All tests are taken in-class and on-line via Schoology.

The Unit Tests start at **25 points** and increase over the course of the year until they max out at **100 points**. (Unit 1 is worth 25 pts; Unit 2: 50 pts; Unit 3: 75 pts; Unit 4: 100 pts; Unit 5: 100 pts; Unit 6: 100 pts.) While not open for re-assessment, all Unit Tests are curved.

Different kinds of test-taking strategies will be discussed to help alleviate anxieties as well as provide students with tips on how to better prepare for such assessments.

Schoology is only used for your Unit Tests. For everything else, use DrHartnell.com.

Most of the test questions will come in the form of "Matching" and "Application".

Question 1
Match the Amendment with its description.

Column A	Column B
1. <u>b</u> No President may be elected to serve more than 2 terms (done in response to FDR's election to 4 terms).	a. 24th Amendment
2. <u>d</u> Washington D.C. is NOT a state, so it wasn't originally worth any Electoral Votes; now worth no fewer than 3 EVs.	b. 22nd Amendment
3. <u>a</u> Outlaws poll taxes (income requirement to vote) in Federal elections; had been used to keep blacks from voting in the South.	c. 25th Amendment
4. <u>c</u> Covers temporary/permanent succession by Vice President if President dies, is sick, or "out of commission" for a short time.	d. 23rd Amendment
5. <u>e</u> Drops voting age from 21 to 18.	e. 26th Amendment
6. <u>f</u> Any new pay raises by Congress don't go into effect until after the next election.	f. 27th Amendment
